MTEC launched 3-Modules of *Clean It Right* on, May 26, 2020. One module each for:

1. Hotels, Motels and Bed & Breakfasts
2. Restaurants and Food Services
3. Retail Establishments

Like the other programs, *Clean It Right for Business Offices and Service Centres* is not meant to replace the company's existing cleaning practices or standards, but to enhance it. The goals are to:

- **Help re-gain consumer and employee confidence** by making the commitment to provide a clean and safe environment for everyone
- **Help people who work in offices and services centres** understand the significance of following the cleaning and disinfection procedures by adjusting current practices

"As soon as we launched the first three-modules we started getting calls asking for training specifically for office environments, so, we developed this new Business Offices and Service Centres training," commented Shannon Fontaine, CEO of MTEC. "It's been a whirlwind, but we're thrilled to offer this training FREE to businesses who are in the tourism, hospitality, retail and customer service industries in Manitoba." Fontaine also reported that **over 3,400 people have registered for the Clean It Right program, and 171 businesses have qualified to be Clean It Right Certified, since it's launch six weeks ago.**

Clean It Right is endorsed by city, provincial and national bodies who are looking for resources to help restore confidence in businesses across all industries in Canada.

MTEC, established in 1989, is a not-for-profit that receives federal and provincial funding to assist the tourism, hospitality and retail industries in Manitoba remain viable by training industry managers, supervisors and employees.
